Overview of CFI's Cambodia Program in relation to the TWG-F&E Workplan for 2006

The mission of Community Forestry International (CFI) is to support the greater engagement of rural communities in forest stewardship. Since 2003, CFI has been working with a wide variety of Cambodian and international organizations to support ongoing forest sector transitions, with an emphasis on community-based forest management. In May 2004, CFI entered into a memorandum of understanding with the Forest Administration to help support sustainable use of forest resources through community forestry. Under the Community Forestry Alliance for Cambodia (CFAC), a program that is funded by USAID and the John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation, CFI has established a small grants facility that provides financial and technical support to local NGOs that are providing field level support to communities engaged in forest protection and management. In addition, CFI has initiated a "Seed Grants" program which provides targeted assistance for CF implementation directly to local communities. This program focuses particularly on communities that do not have support from NGOs or other agencies. Over the past 2.5 years, CFI has made 32 small grants and 15 seed grants, located in 8 provinces. A total of 85 CF sites have received financial and technical support. While some data is not yet available, these sites cover an area of at least 150,595 hectares and benefit more than 16,988 families.

The CFAC project has three foci including support for CF policy and legal formulation, CF extension materials development, and CF program implementation. CFI has worked closely with the Forestry Administration to facilitate input into the framing of the CF Sub-Decree and Implementation Guidelines (*prakas*) and on the development of the National Community Forestry Program (NCFP). CFI also supports the communication of CF information to the public through supporting radio programs, posters and booklets, civil society networks, and training programs.

In relation to the TWG-F&E Workplan for 2006, CFI's activities contribute primarily to the implementation of the National Community Forestry Program, section 3.1. There are also contributions to "Overall Capacity Building Program Forestry Sector" (section 4.1) through CFI's training program designed to improve implementation of community forestry. This training program includes courses on mapping, facilitation skills, forest inventory, and silviculture techniques, among others.
