

Government-Donor Coordination Committee (GDCC) Meeting

– 15 September 2005 –

- 1. Information flows between TWG-F&E and coordinating bodies / line ministries**

As TWG-F&E just has been established, the coordination and communication process is known that insufficient. To improve this weakness, TWG-F&E needs to promote its communication network through the access of information related to its responsible sectors. By doing this, the line ministries such as Ministry of Environment, Ministry of Planning and other donor agencies are required to provide more cooperation within the scope of TWG-F&E TOR in order to implement its tasks effectively. All planning formulated by the Ministry of Planning are required to consult with TWG concerned. This process, the members of all TWGs are allowed to share their opinion for the contribution to the final planning. If we can do that, the TWG's works will be improved.
- 2. TWG-F&E has no fund to implement its Action Plan**

Following the TOR, TWG-F&E has formulated its action plans for 2006 on Forestry and Environment. Unfortunately, this working group does not have enough funds to achieve its goals. With this constrains, TWG-F&E need assistance from donor community.
- 3. TWG-F&E needs to formulate the Long-term Planning**

In order to achieve the key strategy of the development of Cambodia, particularly in the forestry and environment sector, TWG-F&E needs to set the long-term planning for implementing its activities. It should include the one-year planning such as the rolling plans.
- 4. Cross-ministry challenges to ensure the access between FA and MoE**

This point should be the collaboration of the inter-ministries to facilitate the relevant activities such as the Forestry Administration and Ministry of Environment. Both ministries have to cooperate closely to ensure the implementation of TWG-F&E smoothly and effectively.
