Cancun Agreement- UNFCCC, Dec 2010

Developing countries are requested to develop:

- **A national strategy or action plan**
- **A national forest reference level(REL) or subnational reference levels *as an interim measure***
- **A robust and transparent forest monitoring system, subnational *as an interim measure***
- **A system for providing information on how safeguards are being addressed**

REDD Development in Cambodia

- Interim taskforce establishment since Jan 2010: FA, GDANCP, MLMUPC, CCI, RECOFTC
- Objectives: Develop REDD roadmap for UN-REDD or R-PP for Forest Carbon Partnership Facility (FCPF)
- Support UNDP, FAO, Winrock International
- Consultation process:
 - August 2010 – March 2011

Achievement

- **5 Nov 2010: UN-REDD 5th policy board meeting in Washington supported Cambodia proposal (3m)**
 - Donors: EU, Norway, Demark, Spain, JICA
- **25 Mar 2011: 8th Participant Committee of FCPF supported Cambodia R-PP (3.6m)**
 - Donors: USA, UK, Germany, Norway, Japan, AFD, Denmark, etc.
