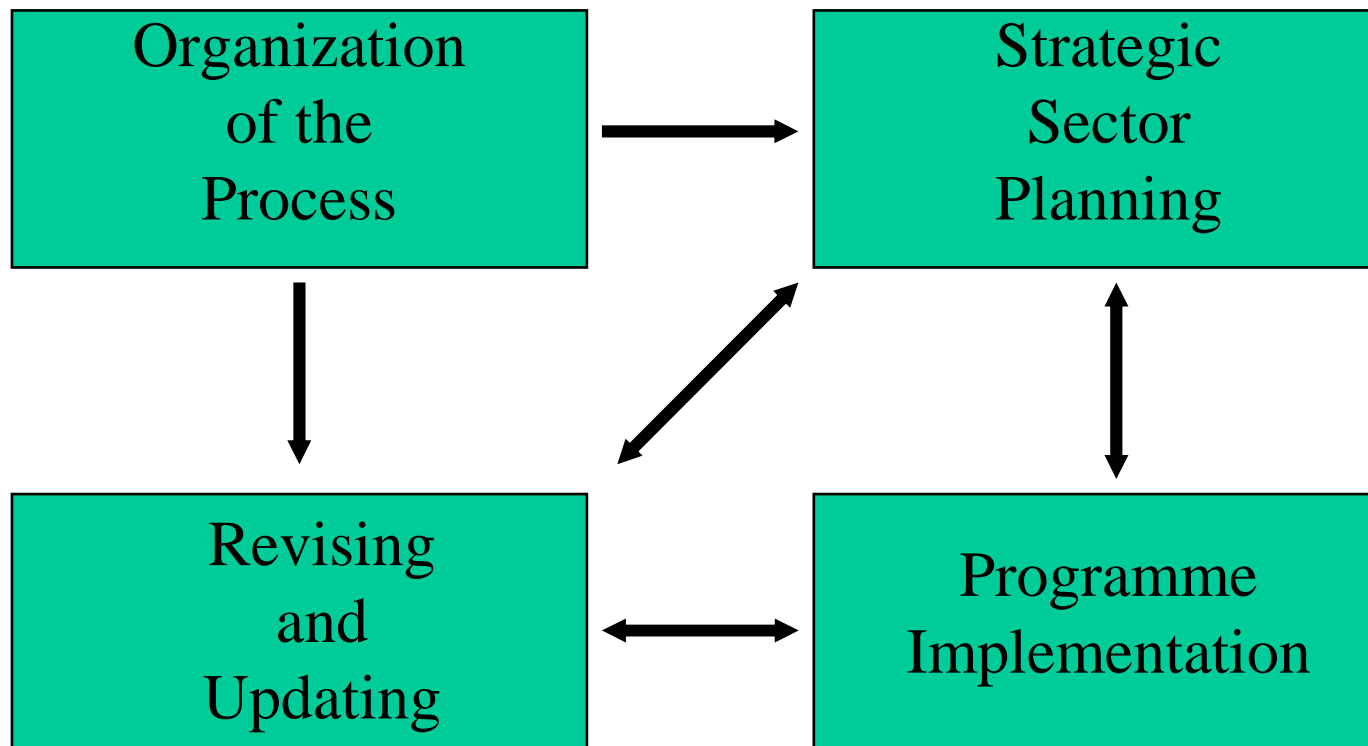

Main phases of the process

1. The organisation of the process including the identification of all stakeholders
2. The strategic planning is an analysis and studies phase incl. review of forestry and related sectors
3. Programme implementation incl. operational planning, securing financing, coordination of implementation, monitoring
4. The revision and updating phase refers to evaluation and revision of the NFP

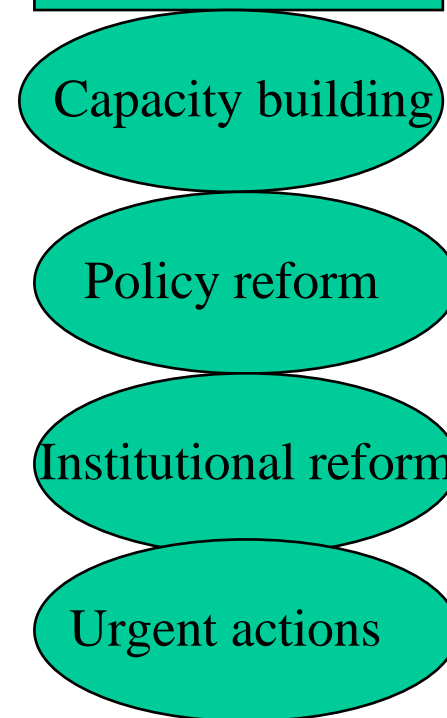
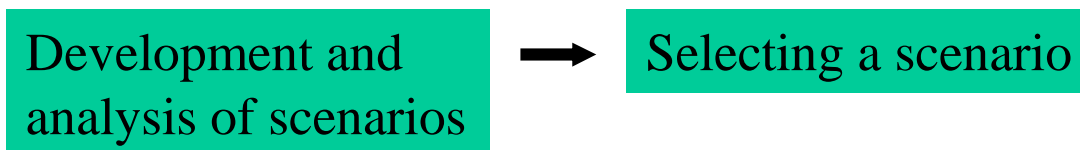

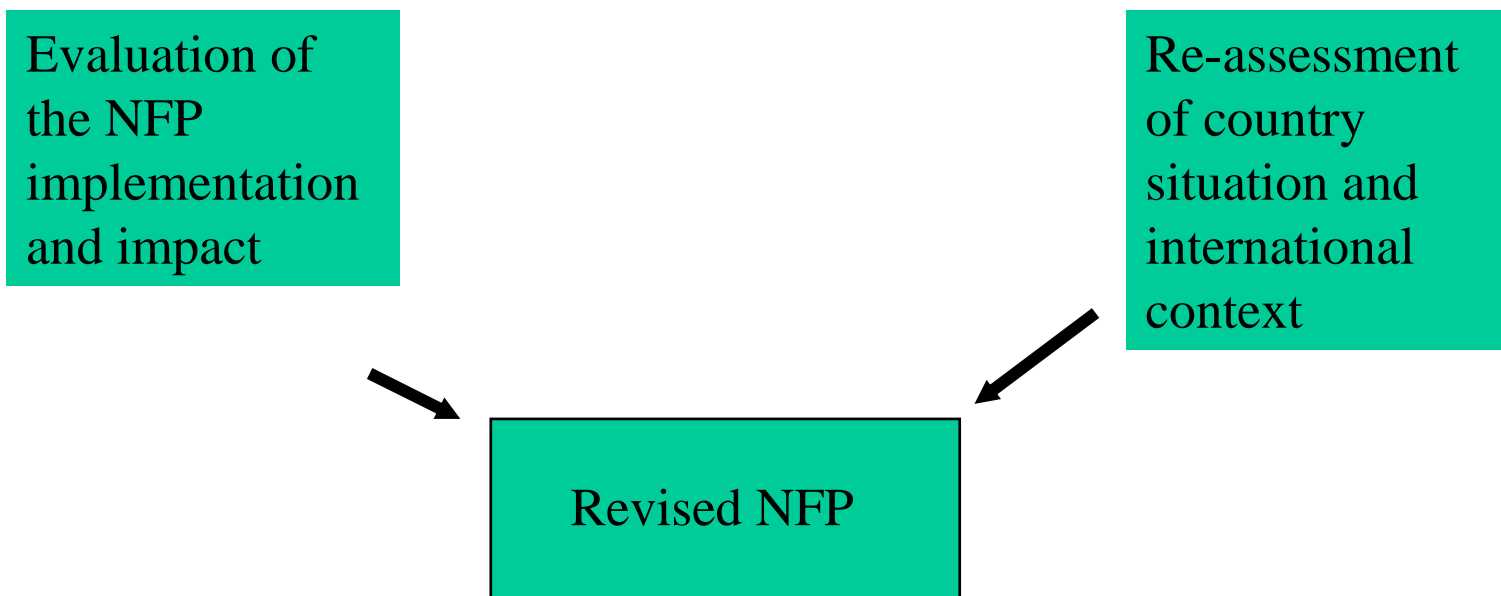
